Naloge

1. Razlika

Za dano število zapisano v desetiškem številskem sestavu poišči razliko med največjim in najmanjšim številom, ki vsebujete enake števke kot prvotno število.

2. Množica Števil

V dani množici naravnih števil poiščite vse pare števil, katerih vsota je dano število.

3. Vedno enako

Napišite program, ki bo številki v zapisu danega števila med 1000 <= n <= 9999, najprej dodal na desni vse štiri števke in tako dobil osemmestno številko. Tako dobljeno število delite s 137 in s številom n. Na koncu izpišite rezultat.

4. Urejanje seznama

Eden od najpreprostejših algoritmov za urejanje seznamov je naslednji:

- Naredimo prehod skozi seznam, pri tem
- primerjamo dva sosednja elementa seznama,
- če nista urejena v predpisanem vrstnem redu ju zamenjamo.
- če sta enaka, enega izločimo.
- To ponavljamo toliko časa, dokler v prehodu skozi seznam ni bila narejena nobena sprememba.

Algoritem se imenuje mehurčkasto urejanje angl. (bubble sort). Spodnje besedilo pretvorite v seznam besed. Pri urejanju izpustite podvojitve.
